5. CAPTAIN'S ACKNOWLEDGMENT

- I am the owner and/or operator ("Captain") of the vessel identified above, and I am solely responsible for its safe operation and for the safety of every person aboard.
- I will comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations, including the Illinois Boat Registration and Safety Act, U.S. Coast Guard regulations, and all posted no-wake and speed restrictions on the Chain O' Lakes and Fox River, and with all Event rules and the instructions of Event staff.
- I will not operate the vessel while under the influence of alcohol, cannabis or any impairing drug, and I will not permit an impaired person to operate it. I understand that Illinois law prohibits operating a watercraft with a blood alcohol concentration of 0.08 or greater.
- The vessel is currently registered, is in safe operating condition, and carries a properly fitting U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device for every person aboard, together with all other legally required safety equipment. I will require all persons under 13 to wear a PFD while underway, and I understand that every participant has separately agreed in the Participant Waiver to wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved PFD while participating.
- I alone decide whether to launch, continue or withdraw in light of weather, water and traffic conditions. River Rumble LLC does not inspect vessels and does not supervise vessel operation.
- River Rumble 2026 is a rally, not a race. No speed or timing competition is sanctioned by River Rumble LLC.
- I will attend the captains' meeting at 10:15 a.m. before departure.
- River Rumble LLC may remove any participant or vessel from the Event at any time, without refund, for unsafe or disruptive conduct.
- Every person aboard my vessel has completed and signed the Participant Waiver (Participant Agreement, Release and Assumption of Risk).
